Report on Review of Constitution and By-Laws of the Jamaica Veterinary Medical Association

In December, 2003, the Jamaica Veterinary Medical Association (JMVA) requested the Staff of the Fair Trading Commission (FTC) to review its Constitution and By-laws in order to determine whether they were in compliance with the provisions of the Fair Competition Act (FCA). The Staff reviewed the documents and certain provisions relating to restrictions on advertising and fee-setting were found to be in conflict with the FCA. In response to our comments, in July 2006, the JVMA amended the Constitution and By-laws accordingly.
