



## **Litigation conducted by the Fair Trading Commission into Complaints against The Warehouse Limited**

### **The Warehouse Limited**

Overtime the Fair Trading Commission (FTC) consistently received complaints against The Warehouse Limited, a furniture and appliances store, for failing to deliver or late delivery of items purchased from the store. The FTC staff filed suit against the Respondent in respect of these matters. It was heard on November 2, 2005, and the Court ordered:

- (1) A Declaration that the Defendant has contravened the prohibitions and/or the obligations imposed in Part VII of the Fair Competition Act and /or in particular that the Defendant has in the course of business engaged in Misleading Advertising in breach of Section 37 of the said Act.
- (2) Costs to the Claimant to be taxed if not agreed.
