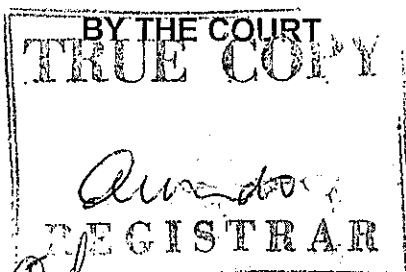

- (b) That the Respondent do pay to the Crown such pecuniary penalty not exceeding One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the breach so declared.
- (c) Costs to the Applicant in accordance with Schedule A of Attorney's Costs Rules.
