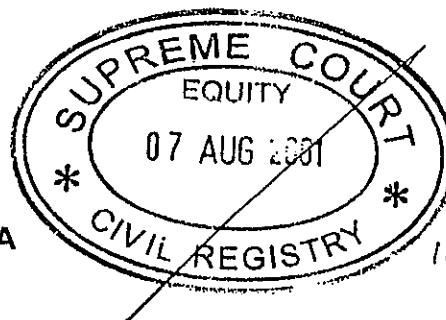

The Respondents do jointly and/or severally pay the sum of Seven Hundred  
Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) to the Crown for breach of Section 37 of the
