20 - 23 JULY 2026

Paramaribo, 6th JULY 2026 - The CARICOM Competition Commission (CCC) is proud to announce its **Inaugural Competition and Consumer Welfare Conference**, to be held virtually from **20–23 July 2026**.

The conference will bring together leading international experts, competition authorities, consumer agencies, policymakers, regulators, academics, and practitioners to discuss emerging issues in competition law and policy, consumer protection, digital markets, market enforcement, and regional cooperation.

The first three days of the conference will feature presentations and panel discussions on a range of contemporary competition and consumer welfare topics. **Thursday, 23 July 2026**, will be dedicated to a special programme for sector regulators, focusing on the interface between regulation, competition, and consumer protection.
